

## Building the Education Revolution

We have been approved for a new \$250,000 Classroom facility in the Governments 'Primary Schools for the 21st Century'.

### Primary Schools for the 21st Century (P21)

The Commonwealth Government has committed funding of \$14.7 billion over the next three years to provide new facilities and refurbishments in Australian schools to meet the needs of the 21st century for students and teachers through the Building the Education Revolution (BER) program.

For our Matthew Hogan School this means that we have been approved funding of \$250,000 (P21 program) for construction of a new classroom and \$50,000 (National Pride Program) for the refurbishment of existing classrooms.

### P21 Program (\$250,000)

This program includes the removal and disposal of 6 old deteriorating demountables currently used as classrooms, and to replace it, the construction of a new multipurpose classroom facility. This new classroom will give our young people a more up-to-date facility to help enhance their studies and further more there future.

### The National Pride Program (\$50,000)

This program has allowed Matthew Hogan School to upgrade and refurbish our existing facilities including the following:

- Refurbishment of 3 existing classrooms – included painting, new guttering, new doors and locks
- Construction of 3 new under cover awnings and steps for each of the 3 classrooms
- Protective cages for lights in Multipurpose court
- Installation of external heater to school lunch area
- Purchasing of new tables and chairs for students
